The 2009 Engagement Forum will be presented by the Department of Education and Training, the Association of Independent Schools (AISWA) and the Catholic Education Office (CEO). The Forum will be held in conjunction with the Western Australian District High Schools Administrators Association (WADHSAA), the Western Australian Secondary Schools Executive Association (WASSEA) and the West Australian Education Support Principals and Administrators Association (WAESPAA).

The 2009 theme "Moving Forward" sets the scene for a sustainable future, with the Forum focusing on building capacity within schools, training organizations and local community providers.
