### AREDV2 - Applications for Rapid E-learning Development

#### About AREDV2

AREDV2 is an e-learning development tool designed to allow teachers and trainers, with little more than basic computer skills, to easily build their own e-learning resources using six dynamic templates. The templates are based on media-rich interactions that are commonly used in e-learning materials and remove the need for practitioners to learn the multimedia skills commonly required to build such resources.

AREDV2 enables practitioners to take their own content, integrate it into a template and publish a fully-functional, engaging e-learning resource they can deliver via CD-ROM, website or learning management system.

#### Who is AREDV2 for?

This project will be of interest to:

- e-learning resource and content developers
- practitioners who would like to easily develop and create educationally sound e-learning resources
- e-learning resource development managers
